

Information sheet for visiting scholars

What we offer:

- An opportunity to interact with the legal and policy community for data protection and privacy in Brussels. The Hub will introduce the scholars within its strategic networks, allowing the visiting scholar to fully exploit the data privacy capital with its extensive impact on privacy and data protection.
- Visiting scholars will be provided with office space and access to university resources.
- The duration of the visit may vary, with a minimum of two weeks. Longer stays, to facilitate, sabbaticals, can be envisaged.
- Support for external funding applications can be provided. Please mention in your application if you intend to apply for such funding.

How to apply:

- Send a message to info@brusselsprivacyhub.eu with your contact details, information about your home institution, your research topic, your CV and a short explanation on how your research would profit from a stay with the Brussels Privacy Hub.
- Applications are evaluated on an ongoing basis, there are no fixed deadlines for applications.

What will be expected of you during your stay:

- Contribute one Working Paper to the <u>Brussels Privacy Working Paper Series</u>.
- Organise one weekly research gathering (WRG).

To take care of before arrival:

- Scholars must make their own accommodation, insurance, visa, and transportation arrangements.
- Scholars should send in a photo with a short biography for the Brussels Privacy Hub Website to enhance the visibility of <u>visiting scholars</u>.
- Practical guidance and support will be provided via the staff.
