Brussels Privacy Hub Privacy and Data Protection Doctoral Seminars. The science of access request; empowering citizens in practice? René Mahieu

The right of access is a central aspect of the GDPR in a system of transparency which ought to empower the citizen to protect her privacy. During this seminar René will discuss his research plans and questions, revolving around the question: How and to what extent does the exercise of the right access meet its objectives in practice?

He will introduce "*DatainSight*", a citizen science platform that fuels the empirical research by allowing citizens to create access requests and share the results with researchers. The platform will allow building a crowd sourced dataset which will function as a ground truth for assessing the right of access in practice.

On a theoretical level the research will focus on questions like: What are the theoretical underpinnings, the *raison d'etre* for the right of access? And: How do these underpinnings relate to processes of collectivization?

A first paper Collectively Exercising the Right of Access: Individual Effort, Societal Effect gives an example of the type of work to be done in this research project.
